On March 27th, McComb Economic Development Organization met with Small Nation in Bellefontaine, Ohio. Small Nation develops places, spaces, and dreams for small towns and small-town entrepreneurs across the country. Their mission is to be a resource for others who need assistance in discovering how to approach the overwhelming task of revitalizing their dying towns.

Small Nation has taken Bellefontaine, a town that was 80% vacant and empty at the time, pulled together a team that could renovate buildings and create new businesses, and created life / injected new energy into their community. Ten years later, it is a bustling, industrious town, full of energy and opportunity for locals and visitors alike. Once vacant and dilapidated buildings are now strong, vibrant, welcoming places of business.



The Small Nation tour in Bellefontaine led McComb EDO around the town, in and out of buildings that house stores, restaurants, and loft-style apartments. We discussed what the facilities looked like initially and what it took to bring them to the successful states they are in today. This tour has taught us many things about revitalizing a town and has set our minds whirling with ideas for our beloved McComb.

They will be touring the town, learning more about our community, and offering suggestions on how we might be able to implement creativity, hard work, and the community's desire for growth and industry in our little village.

Hearthside Food Solutions – Partnering With Our Community

Hearthside Food Solutions is focused on increasing their level of civic involvement with the Village of McComb and neighboring communities. Giving back to the cities and towns where Hearthside employees work and live is a priority for the Hearthside management team.

In 2021, Hearthside has committed to becoming more involved with local events, charities, service organizations, and schools. In the course of reengaging with the community, Hearthside has interfaced with local organizations, such as McComb Schools, McComb Economic Development Organization, Findlay – Hancock County Economic Development Organization, McComb Village Council, and McComb Rotary Club.

To this end, Hearthside partnered with McComb High School for a Community Clean-up Day. Twenty-five McComb High School students met at the McComb plant for a day of learning and earning community service credits. The students were broken up into groups in partnership with several Hearthside employees to help clean up trash from neighboring homes and community properties. Several residents shared their appreciation for Hearthside take a leading role in demonstrating community pride, and involving both employees and local youth.

After the clean-up, the students were provided with lunch, and participated in interactive sessions with the Hearthside team. The focus of these was to familiarize the students with manufacturing as a career field, Hearthside as a company, and the broad variety of professional roles and job opportunities at Hearthside.

Looking forward, Hearthside is excited to continue building on this effort. Among the activities in the works for Hearthside is helping to refresh the 2021 McComb Cookie Festival and establishing routine partnerships to help prepare high school students for direct entry into the workplace or planning a path for continued education.
